- The VET education is a natural bridge between school and the world of work, aiming to equip the future workforce with the necessary skills and competences, including the green and digital ones.

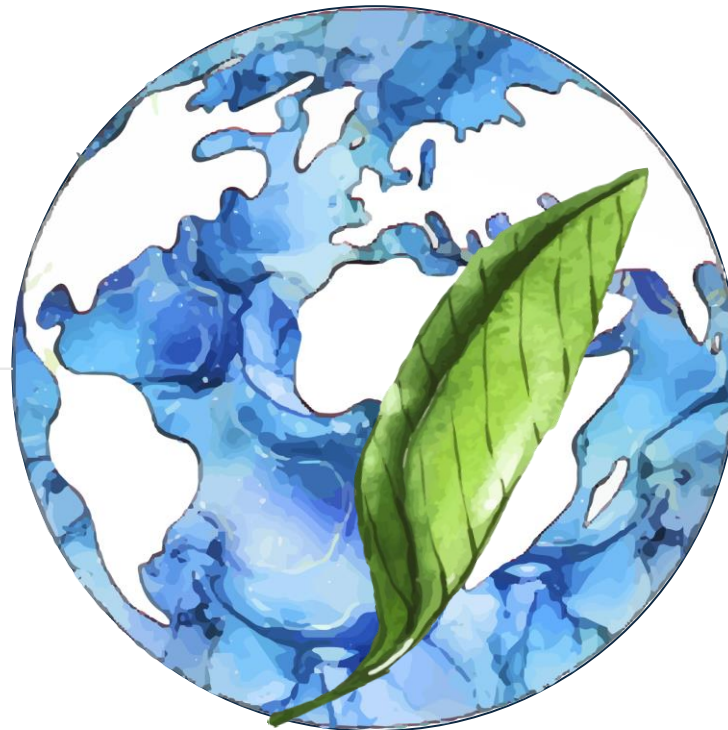
Meeting the need for green skills means for us:

Learners have the chance to understand the inter-connectedness of economic, social and natural systems and move from awareness to individual and collective action

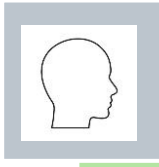

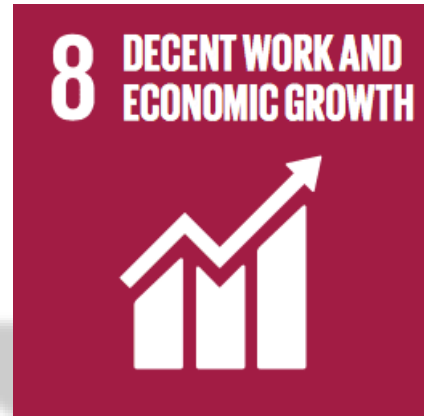
