What is an LTA?

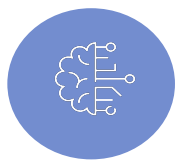

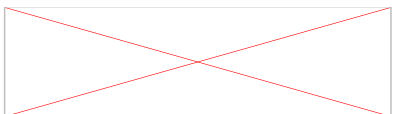

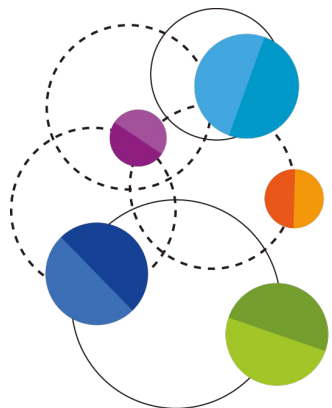
