	OPTION 1: AMSTERDAM - Cybersoek	
	Cybersoek is a free digital support platform located in places like libraries and community centers across Amsterdam. It helps residents improve their digital skills through one-on-one coaching, group workshops, and special programs such as language courses and job-seeking support. During the site visit, participants will tour the Amsterdam-East library location and learn about their approach.	
	OPTION 2: UTRECHT – Digiwijs	
	Digiwijs is a community-based digital empowerment initiative in Utrecht, Netherlands, located in a public library. In partnership with VodafoneZiggo, it offers free services such as affordable internet, refurbished devices, and digital skills workshops to help residents fully participate in the digital world. During the site visit, participants will explore the services Digiwijs provides across Utrecht.
