




It funds, coordinates, and monitors Further Education and Training provision in Ireland







Who is the FET Learner?




FET Beneficiary Numbers 2018 – 2022/23

The Further Education & Training System 2022-2024





FET College of the Future



Consolidation: Consolidate existing FET provision within a single integrated college structure that incorporates the previous functions of both colleges of further education and training centres.


